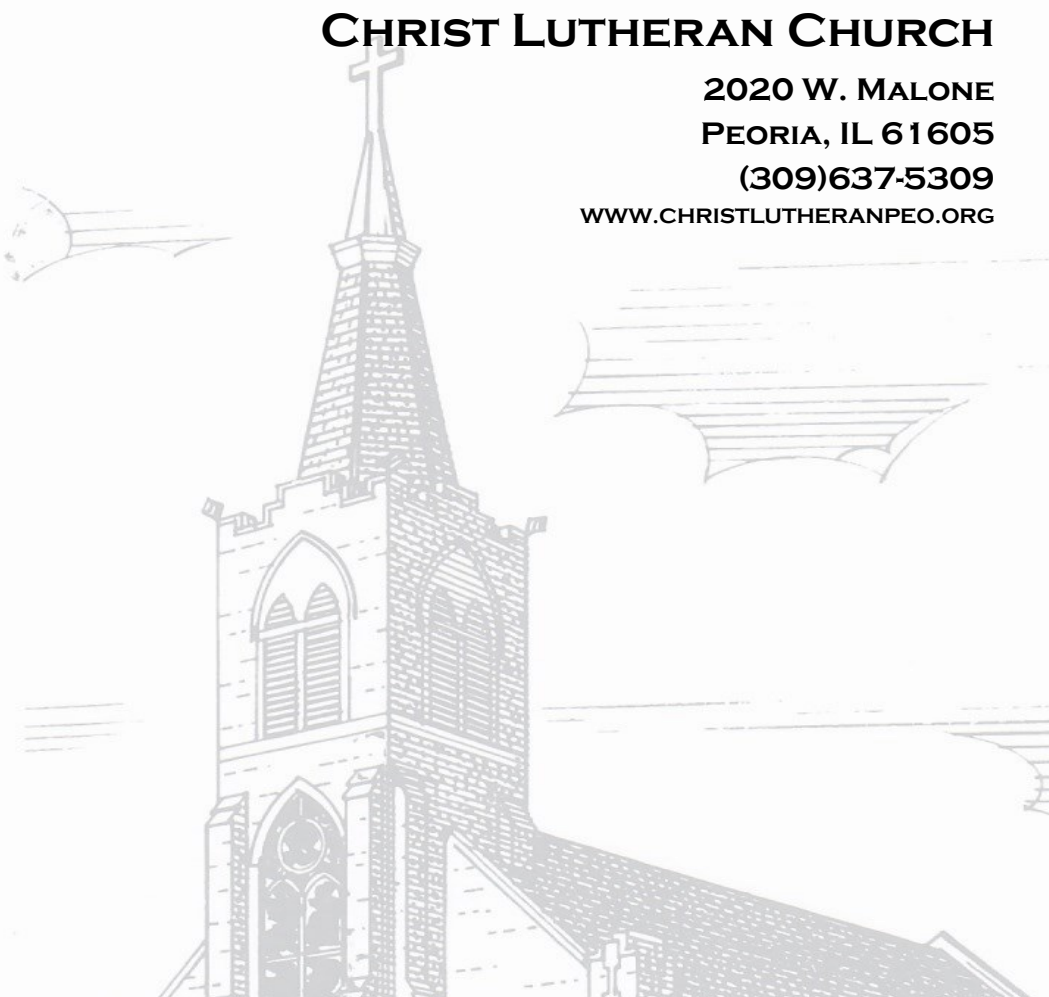

LWML MITES COLLECTION—The Central Illinois District LWML announced a mission goal for 2021-2022 of \$105,000, with \$78,750 for district grants and the remaining funds for national mission grants. The first CID grant to be funding for \$20,000 is the "Student Aid for Church Workers". Due to the high cost of becoming a full-time church worker, many students find it difficult to complete their schooling. This grant will provide partial funding to CID students to become full-time church workers.
